This Level 1 Journal is designed for non-readers and very young readers. It uses lots of pictures and activities to captivate young children's interest as they study God's Word.

Young children will need help with the Level 1 pages. These pages can be used to prepare young children for Family Bible Study or to keep a young child occupied during Family Bible Study. They can also be used independently of the Family Bible Study.

The activities in this journal will require a pencil and color crayons. If you want to do the optional activities, you may also include one container of play dough, pipe cleaners, and glue. It might be helpful to have these items set aside in a "Bible Study Basket", ready for use during Family Bible study.

Circle the pictures below that show children who are obeying God. Cross out or cover with play dough the pictures that show children who are disobeying God.




Reading the Bible

Being kind to other people





Lesson Three, Level One

Bend pipe cleaners into heart shapes and glue around each heart. Or, color the hearts.




Wisdom Talks


A Man Who Prayed
